VHF/DSC - SHORT RANGE CERTIFICATE COURSE PRE-COURSE REQUIREMENTS

To prepare yachtsmen for VHF communications in the GMDSS era, the MCA/RYA have introduced the VHF/DSC Short Range Certificate (SRC). The SRC has replaced the VHF Operators Certificate and is now the minimum radio qualification in the UK (existing holders of a VHF Radio Operators Certificate are still legal to operate the old style VHF radios, but must now update to SRC if they fit or operate VHF/DSC.

The SRC is a mandatory qualification for operators on small craft fitted with VHF Digital Selective Calling (DSC).

PRE-COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

- Fluency in the phonetic alphabet
- One passport photograph with your name on the reverse
- Cheque, for £60 made payable to the RYA for exam & certificate issue.

RYA VHF/DSC MARINE RADIO SHORT RANGE CERTIFICATE ONE DAY COURSE

The Course is 10 HOURS including up to 3 hours guided self learning prior to the course and includes the RYA VHF HANDBOOK . You will also have to pay a £60 RYA LICENCE FEE.The Centre is equipped with two VHF/SRC Training Simulator radios and a computer simulator.

The RYA SRC Course is a one day course, with a requirement for 7 hours training on the day. Light refreshments will be provided for breaks. The cost of the course is £95 (20% discount for HYCC or BSAC members, proof required).

COURSE ITINERARY (which may vary slightly)

• The morning session will start at 09.00 hours and will cover the practical operation of

a marine VHF, emergency equipment and an introduction to GMDSS.

• Short Lunch Break at approximately 13.00 hours - bring a snack.

The afternoon session will start at 13.30 hours and covers Distress, Urgency, Safety and other communication procedures.
Completion of course at 16.30 hours approximately followed by debriefing.

You must then take a practical radio exercise and a written exam paper with mainly multiple choice answers. This takes about 30-60 minutes and is relatively easy. This is usually arranged within two days of the one day training course to suit the pupil.
